Trade: Averon, Chi'tixi, CM, Kachar, Taneki

DP: Failed

Tinikatua III died in a fit of pique after the Kop'chay hive again refused the advances of her diplomats and remained happy with simple tribute. She was succeeded by Tinikatua IV.

DUCHY OF TANEKI (8 I/YG)

*Her Grace, Toktoka II, Mistress of Aketl, Duchess of Taneki, Baroness Ketatl, Imperial Governor of Tramelis.*

Trade: Averon, Chi'tixi, Itaxik, Kachar, Pexiki, Tokatl

DP: None

The Duchess continued to expand her military forces to the delight of the Equerries and the general indifference of the remainder of her subjects.

THE CHURCH MILITANT (9 I/IL)

*Her Holiness Aketika VI, Iluvarian Matriarch of the West, Archemondrite of Tikata.*

Trade: Averon, Tokatl

DP: None

Aketika VI personally oversaw the construction of a road from Tikata into the hill country. She is looking for workers to continue the road as far as the fortress of Ta'chitix.

ELECTORAL GRAND DUCHY OF AVERON (13 SI/IL)

*His Gracious Majesty, Muldalan II, Lord of Clan Drax, Count of Darida, Electoral Grand Duke of Averon.*

*Tiketua of Tishrak, Margrave of the North.*

Trade: Atuburrk, Chi'tixi, CM, Taneki, Tokatl

DP: None

In 1448, Sardulan the Bold died of an acute sinus infection, and his nephew assumed the throne as Muldalan II. Unfortunately, several prefectures took the opportunity to voice their dissatisfaction with Averese rule by refusing to swear allegiance to

the new Elector. Tramades, Dorrial, Adres, Vendeer, and Teumeda all rebelled.

COUNTY OF PEXIKI (16 1/YG)

*Her Excellency, Ixix III, Mistress of the Coactoka Hive, Countess of Pexiki, Lady Amoxcali.*

Trade: Itaxik, Kachar, Taneki

DP: None

The death of Nixitix the Do-Nothing in 1446 came as a welcome relief to the Pexiki. Many are hoping that the new Countess can stem the bleeding of prefectures to the Xinite heretics. A Xinite army of nearly 30,000 was defeated in a sharp battle in Kisar, reconquering the region for Pexiki.

ELECTORAL GRAND DUCHY OF ITAXIK (21 1/UR)

*Her Gracious Majesty, Chass'ika I, Mistress of the Tis'chak, Countess of Takkikik, Electoral Grand Duchess of Itaxik, Golden Beetle of the West, Imperial Governor of Chos and Kastier.*

Trade: Kachar, Pexiki, Sakkar, Taneki, Yax'te

DP: None

The new Grand Duchess Cipactonatha died unexpectedly in 1449, to be succeeded by the personable and well-liked Chass'ika. She was quickly appointed to her predecessor's titles.

COUNTY OF KACHAR (7 1/UR)

*Her Excellency, Kassa III, Mistress of Calpolli, Lady Tchantli, Countess of Kachar, Protector of the Fair Isles.*

Trade: Itaxik, Sakkar, Taneki, Tokatl, Yax'te

DP: None

Kachar continues to lobby the Emperor for the Governorship of Endior.

BARONY OF SAKKAR (7 1S/IL)

*Baroness Neallatalah II of Sakkar, Mistress of Nelhuayotl, Heir of the Prophet, Beloved of the Light of Iluvar.*

Trade: Itaxik, Kachar, Yax'te

DP: None

The Sakkar continued to invest. Their government (such as it is) expanded.

ICEMARK OF YAX'TE (6 S/IL)

*Margrave Tillein the Silent, Grand Master and Knight-Commander of the Champions of the Renewal.*

DP: None

The Yax'te settled Saurian refugees in Alonwë to build a river port town in the forest, which they named Beech, presumably for the trees.

ELECTORAL QUEENDOM OF THE GREAT HIVE OF CHI'TIXI TIRRIX KI (36 1/YG)

*Her Most Puissant Majesty, Xant'ki VIII, Mistress of Tirrix & the Great Hive, Duchess of Chax and Tix'itikata, Countess Itax, Electoral Queen of Chi'tixi, &c., &c.*

Trade: Adndar, Araxes, Aradéc, Atuburrk, Averon, Cappargarnia, CotI, Golmath, Hyrägec, Ingazi, Kicitchat, Taneki, ThaceD, ThaceE, Tokatl, Urdrahahn

The venerable Antaxi III finally died in 1447. The old, tired Chi'tixi realm got a shot in the arm with the accession of the young and energetic Xant'ki VIII. At least, they hope so.

DUCHY OF THACE (7 S/UR)

The Ducal court got a bit of a scare when Willor came down with a nasty cough. Fortunately, he got better. Herroc was expanded into a city, and investments in sorcery paid off. The Duke's son, Count Biard, continued to train with the Duke's elephant army.

*His Most Excellent Majesty, Ebalondrir III, Lord Goshtikka-Snamarthis, Electoral Count Palatine in Thace.*

*Basodir the Bold, Baron of Galluch, Marshal of Thacia.*

Ebalondrir continued his policies of military expansion and economic development. A legate from Urdraháhn inspected the various religious sites in the area and met with the Elector.

**THE TIGERS OF URDA (0 S/TU)**

*Sar Gortahn, Master of the Horseclans, Scourge of Urda the Fierce.*

Trade: We don't trade with infidel or heretics.

Sar Darrion finally died in 1448, and the horseclans met in the ruins of Assarnes and chose his grandnephew as their new leader. Sar Gortahn has thus far not displayed the horse-tail banner of war.

**GRAND DUCHY OF ARAXES (19 W/UR)**

*His Grace, Pangku Kapalless II, Baron Pinyerrel, Grand Duke of All Araxes.*

Araxes grew fat and rich on trade. Naval quality improved, and a second arsenal was constructed at Nigata. The Baron's nephew and heir, Count Pangku Tramandes of Thangkar, won the Pinyerrel tourney three years running.

*Her Excellency, T'cha'k IV, Lady Tchac'at, Countess of the Kicitchat Hive and Associated Dominions, Imperial Governor of Artier.*

Kicitchat continued to expand its armies and kept a wary eye on the steppe...

*His Gracious Majesty, Adhanggar Challik III, Count of Odol, Elector & Grand Duke of Atuburrk, Imperial Governor of Ardebon.*

The ancient Elector Caranthes III stopped breathing in the cold winter of 1447. Due to his general lethargy in the past decade, it was almost a day before anybody noticed.

The mothers of Clan Adhanggar met in the spring and chose the young and charismatic Challik as Grand Duke. This did not go over well in certain circles, and Challik's dour cousin Dranthes attempted a palace coup. The Adhanggar Guard, however, quickly put a bloody stop to what the Captain called "this nonsense". Inh Odol bore the brunt of the battle and was reduced to a town. Dranthes and a handful of his supporters escaped the general and gleeful massacre and fled to exile in Zadres.

Cappargarnia continued to wallow in its inactivity, perhaps inspired by the supreme indifference of its wastrel Prince, who spent much of his time drinking and whoring in the slightly less reputable sections of the city. The Senate provided for the functioning of the bureaucracy, and hushed discussions were held in cloakrooms and nearby taverns about the Prince's future.

Meanwhile in Zadres, Cappargarnian Admiral Tiribissi Taræc took up her duties as an *Imperial Vice-Admiral*.

**CHURCH OF THE ILLIMITABLE (9 TA)**  
*His Great Holiness, Fenric II, the Impenetrable, Pontiff of the Hidden Lords at Golluz.*

Fenric wheezed and shivered and occasionally trumpeted. His sole religious activity seems to have been convening a committee on appropriate pontifical headwear. He himself continued to wear a large purple and scarlet hood with hanging bells in public. At least people know when he's coming.

**IMPERIAL FREE CITY OF ADNDAR (14 M/TA)**  
*His Excellency Tiribissi Dranthes, Guildmaster of the Chandlers and Burgrave of Adndar.*

Adndar ran smoothly, raking in the money. The council expressed some worry about Dranthes' designated heir, Dranthes Jr. His nickname is "the turnip" and it doesn't appear to stem from his gingery fur.

### THE IMPERIAL DEMENSE

*His August & Imperial Majesty, Paharnes VII, Baron of Wanumarra, Electoral King of Aradéc, Sovereign of Sahûl, Lord of the Nine Hills of Sardarthion, Holder of the Emerald Throne, and Emperor of All the World.*

*His Excellency, Count Kerens III, Baron Kwiklyn, Count of Tiryowglas, Defender of the Faith, Chancellor of the Empire.*

The Emperor grew ever more rotund under the influence of the Imperial Court, whose officials and functionaries kept him busy with the minutiae of Imperial protocol, dress, and (above all) the table. With the death of Countess Tinikatua III of Tokatl, the Admiralty of the Green fell vacant.

Old Prince Dallyn continued the long, arduous task of rebuilding his army and his realm. The walls of the fortress of Dyghow were rebuilt to something approaching their former greatness.

#### BARONY OF FELL KOMMOLEK (15 M/YG)

*Baron Goesek Annavas of Kommolek, Lord Treskaw, Burgrave of Fair Belsünd.*

The truce with Duedhyn continued to hold. Farther south, however, the troubles continued. The last of the population of Uernos fled after the snow that fell during the harsh winter of 1447 failed to melt during the following summer. With starvation the only alternative, the refugees fled to Tenuos. In desperation, they pillaged the countryside and ultimately sacked the town of Kedhlow in their quest for food and shelter. It took the baron himself, and the baronial army, to calm the situation and restore order.

The baron's son, the dashing Lord Terthynn, attended the Uermos Military Academy, graduating second in his class.

#### COUNTY OF TIRYOWGLAS (13 M/IL)

*Lord Kwikyn Sarrik, Regent of Tiryouglas.*

With his father the Count now firmly ensconced as Imperial Chancellor in Sardarthion, Lord Sarrik took the opportunity to tour his future realm. He then gathered the barons together in Caranes for a parliament and tourney, where Saurian Dame Tesenn took the cake.

#### ILUVARIAN ORTHODOX CHURCH (20 IL)

*His All Holiness, Harmony VII, Pontiff of Sistrameides, Archemandrite of Ilúhir.*

Pope Harmony ruled in, er, harmony. The Priory of Anjydh was built in Nandhu on the caravan route near Bodraháhn.

#### MOST SANGUINE DUCHY OF ELPHÁREC (13 W/IL)

*His Grace, Eparreb Tashnes II, Count of Angúron and Siddhan, Duke of Elphárec.*

The Duke continued to be insufferably smug about what a lovely little realm he ruled. The most realistic of his advisors (who happened to be his nephew and heir) pointed out that the little duchy was quite hemmed in by her neighbours.

The Wizarding school at Epadh was expanded into a new University.

#### KINGDOM OF HYRÁGEC (15 W/UR)

*His Valiant Majesty Irrjir Rahnes V, Crook-Nose, King of Hyrágec, Beloved of Urda.*

Prince Torthes' irritating tics and his constant stream of inappropriate remarks and off-colour jokes continued to scandalize the court. His father the king was ill for much of the time, and so fearful are the nobles of his passing that there is talk of convening the Irrjir clan mothers to replace the Prince with his younger sister. There was even some grumbling that perhaps the ancient house of Irrjir had played itself out at last.

COUNTY PALATINE OF INGAZI (6 W/UR)

*His Most Urdan Excellency, Gwariva Razhim IX, Overlord of Gawan, Captain of the East Riding, Count Palatine of Ingazi.*

Razhim IX caught pneumonia during the harsh winter of 1447. While he eventually recovered, his health continues to dicey. Still, he may well become the first Count Palatine to die of natural causes in over a century. Just in case, Razhim's cousin Laharnes was appointed heir by the Gwariva clan mothers. The Council of Ministers, meanwhile, continued to pay the (considerable) bills.

CHURCH UNIVERSAL & TRIUMPHANT (13 UR)  
*Her All-Holiness Ardonia XIV, Claw of the Dragon, First Matriarch of Urda, Protector of Sahúl.*

Trade: Adndar, Araxes, Aradéc, Atuburrk, Cappargarnia, Chi'tixi, Dynath (3), Golmath, Hyrágec, Ingazi, Istahn (1), Madramityi (3)

The wizened Jerröe VIII finally died in 1449. The Sibyl came out of her ritual trance with the name of the Abbess of Harlech on her bloody and foam-flecked lips with the murmured motto "claw of the dragon". The young Abbess, in Urdraháhn

on pilgrimage, was immediately presented to the Sibyl. The Sibyl sniffed her twice, and immediately collapsed and did not awaken for four days. The new First Matriarch took the name Ardonia in honour of the ancient prophet.

Corruption in the church, meanwhile, continued unabated.

ELECTORAL GRAND DUCHY OF GOLMATH (18 W/TA)  
*His Gracious Majesty, Walarri Parndarra II, Baron of Madran and Kamadhi, Count of Agdora, Elector and Grand Duke of Golmath.*

The doddering old Grand Duke gathered all his nobles around him in Golmath, which had somehow become a real city at some point. For what reason, none knew, and Parndarra wasn't letting on. For nearly two years the gathered clans hung around before the Grand Duke finally told them: the Walarri clan mothers had chosen his son Sardhan as heir to replace the late, lamented Lord Endarra. And the clans were darn well going to swear fealty now, *before* he was dead. With the Grand Duke's armies (and assassins) lurking nearby, they all did.

ELECTORAL KINGDOM OF ARADÉC (30+11 W/IL)  
*His Majesty, Prince Sansollen Deric, Prince-Regent of Aradéc.*

Prince Deric spent much of his time hawking in the Marrgalayi Forests while his bucolic little Realm ran itself. Admiral Princess Dagamiri once again eloquently advocated for the expansion of the already mighty Aradécian Navy.

COUNTY OF MURALI (5 W/TA)  
*His Excellency, Kilyara Drathnes II, the Lumberjack,  
 Baron of Karrka, Count of Murali.*  
 Trade: Aradéc, Runazar, Tiryowglas, Zarkhandu  
 DP: None

Murali suffered during the deep winter of 1447, with many of the hinterlands cut off from the towns until the thaw finally came in summer. Fortunately, the next few winters weren't nearly as bad, and the doughy little county rebounded.

The count continued his hobby of chopping down trees, much to the amusement of visiting merchants from cosmopolitan Sarsis. New wooden sidewalks were laid in Karrka, and the river port town of Intix was built in Karyi.

*His Excellency, the Volpel Zhotek, Baron Volpel &

It was cold, colder than usual. Count Zhotek continued to confound his grand-nephews and great grand-nephews by simply continuing to survive. Two more heirs died of old age, leaving Lord Volpel Draktich as heir presumptive. In 1450 the County celebrated the Count's 75th birthday with festivals and parades throughout Runazar, and a lovely card arrived from the Emperor.

ELECTORAL KINGDOM OF ZARKHANDU (30 S/YG)  
*His Great & Terrible Majesty, Onin Zhur, Lord  
 Sakkath, Count of Vúhlath & Mlideen, Duke of  
 Hyáglión, Electoral King of Zarkhandu.*  
 Trade: Aradéc, Golmath, Murali, Runazar  
 DP: Ha! We laugh at your puny diplomats!

King Onin Tachg died during the harsh winter of 1447. Rumours abounded that his nephew (and heir) Prince Sharret was responsible for "leaving the window open", leading to the draught that did in the old King. Sharret took the throne name

Onin Zhur. He was crowned during the Rending Day holiday, following the traditional oration of the Arch-Priest of Uldûn. As the Arch-Priest's lips were ritually sewn shut, the new King took the customary repast of the old King's liver and, to the great merriment of the court, pronounced that it "needed salt".
